

The Lord Is Risen Hallelujah!

Easter 2018

I am the resurrection, and the life: he that believeth in me, though he were dead, yet shall he live: and whosoever liveth and believeth in me shall never die.

John 11:25-26

The message of Easter morning is that there is no death. Jesus spoke of eternal life and on Easter morning he proved the meaning of the words "he is risen." Each of us makes the resurrection journey, the one that takes us from a selfhood apart from God, to the certainty of Oneness with God. The invitation is: "Awake thou that sleepest, and arise from the dead, and Christ shall give thee light."

At the time of our Easter morning experience, we too rise out of the tomb of human hood, and enter that place where we may say "I have overcome the world, I have risen. I no longer sleep, nor am I counted among the dead." There is no death, life is eternal – I am that life.
